Equality Representatives

The Equality Representatives are the voice of the underrepresented groups of students at Bath Spa University. They campaign for equality, celebrate diversity and bring everybody together. As Equality Representatives it's their responsibility to champion for the voice of students under their remit and promote positive change throughout the University. We have Equality Representatives to demonstrate how Bath Spa University is a safe and welcoming place for all students.

EQUALITY REPS ARE EXPECTED TO

- Consult with Bath Spa students on their experiences and feedback to the Union and University.
- Liaise with the Vice President Community and Welfare and Students' Union staff on a regular basis.
- Attend, read papers and be active in committees and meetings for the role.
- Campaign on issues affecting the group of students you represent.
- Promote your role to students.
- Consider how Union and University policies will affect the group of students you represent and lobby to make changes where necessary.
- Liaise with other Equality and Diversity groups and champions.
